## Louisiana Laws

1.	1915	State Education Committee banned the French language in public schools. (Corporal punishment was allowable to deter the act of speaking French.)
2.	1916	Compulsory attendance: All Louisiana children must attend school until the age of 16 years.
3.	1918	Louisiana Legislative Act 114 stated that German could not be spoken on streets, taught in schools, or printed in newspapers. (Reaction to German aggression in WWI)
4.	1921	Repeal of Act 114
5.	1921	Constitutional Amendment stated languages other than English were prohibited in public schools.
