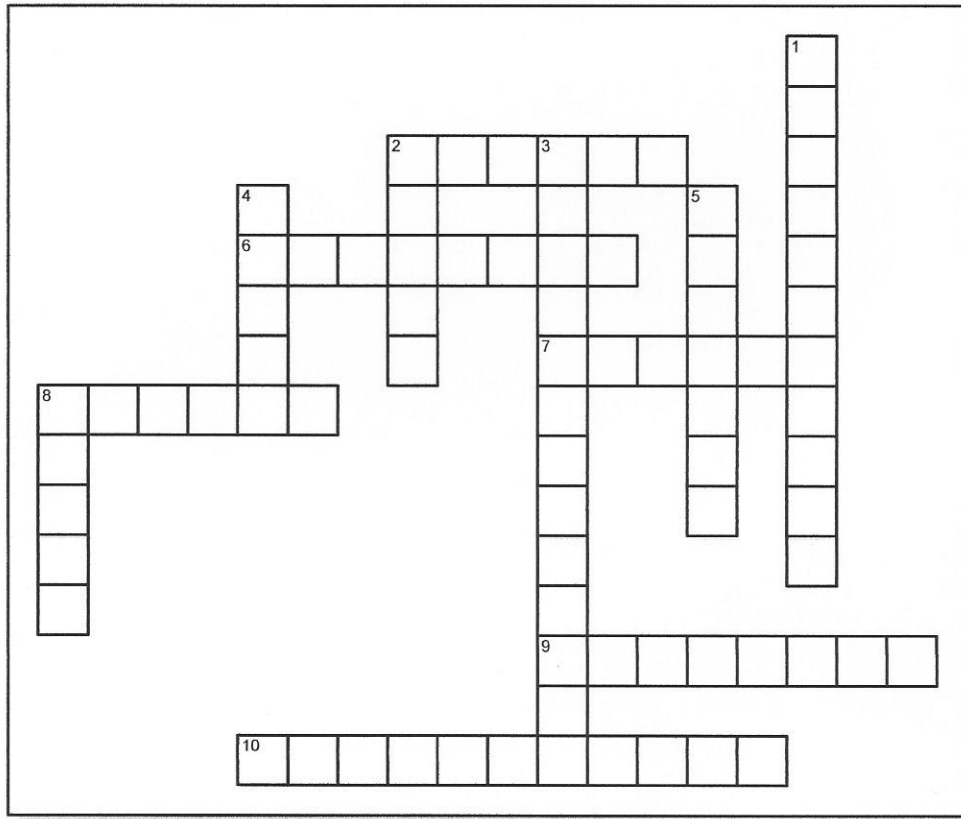

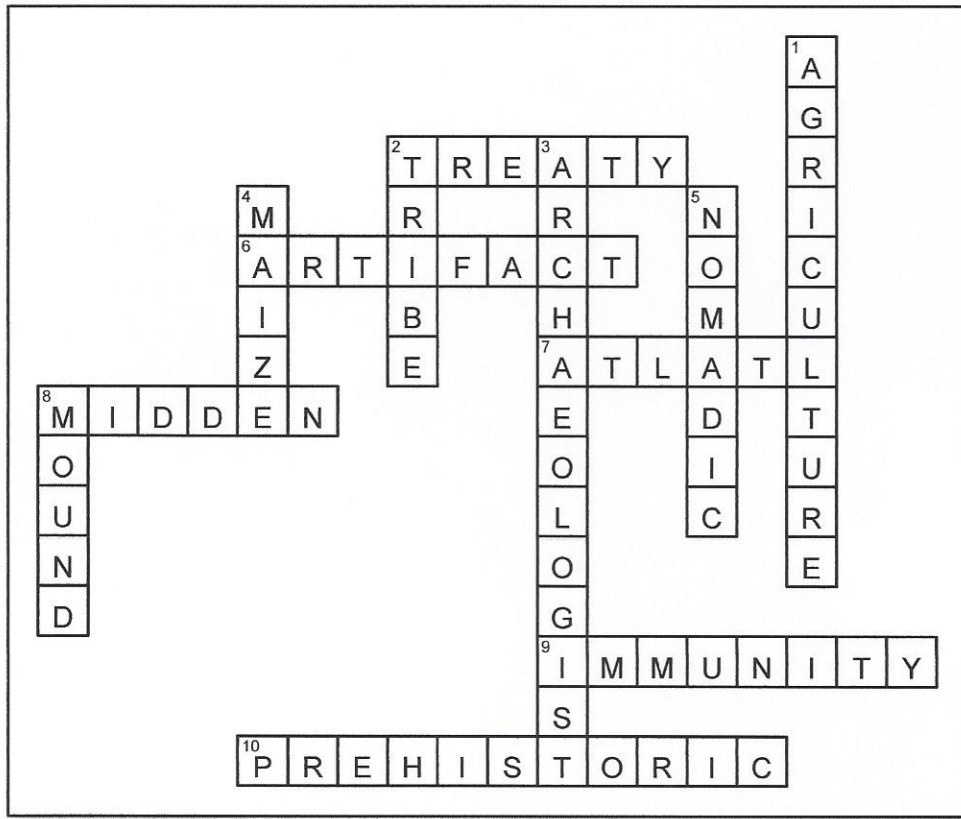
2. a formal agreement between two or more nations
