What was life like in Missouri in the late-1800s? In this lesson, you'll get an idea about that by looking at special "bird's-eye view" maps that were made during that time.

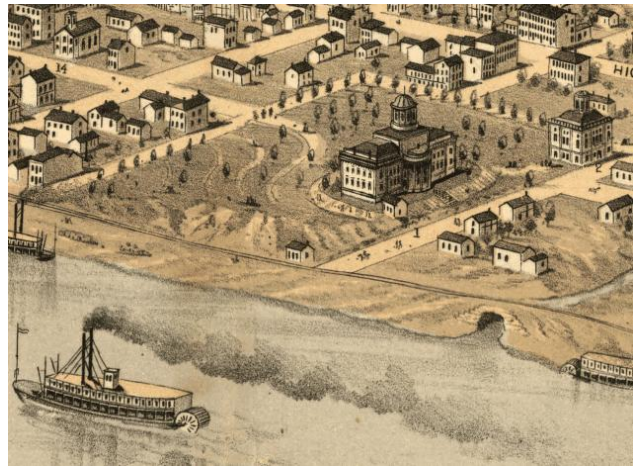
